Topic: Identity Theft

Length: 15 slides (maximum); within the slides, the following information must be indicated:

- A cover slide indicating the following:
 - The presentation title
 - Student's information;
 - Name
 - Grade
 - School's Name
 - Teacher's
- An explanation/definition of Identity Theft
 - This needs to be in the student's own words
- A summary slide with a conclusion (if necessary)
- Resources used within the research process
- A minimum of five (5) ways to avoid becoming a victim of identity theft.
- The following terms and/or concepts:
 - Pretexting
 - Dumpster diving
 - Phishing
 - Smishing
 - Mail theft
- Graphics may be included where appropriate (optional)

The PowerPoint should be created with the audience of the student's peers in mind.
